Next Clemson Photo Shoot Coming Up

The second of four days of photography in Clemson has been scheduled for Sunday, February 8, 2009. The previous photography day was November 14, the Friday before Clemson University Homecoming. Future days will be another weekend (spring) and another weekday (summer); specific dates have not been selected.

Just as the fall day was university-centered, the winter focus is on friends, family, and what people do on winter Sundays in Clemson. We expect to see photographs depicting religion, families at home and with friends, and winter recreation, both indoor and outdoor. The Clemson Photo Archive website at <http://www.exploreats.org> has been updated with new tips for the winter day. People new to the project can find a full description there, including how to package their photographs for submission and where to take them.

Photographs from the November 14 submissions will be on display in a special exhibition at the ARTS Center from January 26 through March 20. A reception will be held Friday February 6 from 7:00pm to 9:00pm in recognition of the project participants and their photography. The exhibition and reception are open to the public and free of charge.

The Clemson Photo Archive Project is a volunteer effort to document the city of Clemson and its people through photography, on specific days in fall, winter, spring and summer. The project, supported by the city of Clemson and operated by the ARTS Center in Clemson, is open to all.
